Course and After bells

As bells change places and hunt up or down, they "follow" each other in a certain order and meet other bells in predictable places.

Your course bell is the bell you follow down to the lead. You ring over/after it in 2nds place before you lead. You lead after that bell, then "take it off the lead". You also ring after your course bell on your first blow at the back.

Your after bell is the bell that follows you down to lead. You ring over it in 2nds place only after you come off the lead. It "takes you off the lead"
